ADELAIDE RALLY OVERVIEW



In 2020 the competitive side of the rally continues to run over 4 days with Challenge and Competition Classes hitting their first stage of the event on the Wednesday at midday. Castambul and Morialta stages at near 19km each have been added in and overall competitive kilometres is increased from the 2019 event. Tour categories get started on Thursday morning, with the Prima Tour starting later and running at the back of the field.

New stages such as Snake Gully and longer versions of traditional stages such as Chain of Ponds Plus make the 2020 event more exciting than ever before. Combined, all category entries are expected to match the capacity field of 324 entries received in 2019 continuing to make the Shannons Adelaide Rally the largest Tarmac Rally field in Australasia.

The event focuses on spirited driving and touring as well as hard-core rallying. Iconic closed road stages throughout the Adelaide Hills, Fleurieu and McLaren Vale Regions feature prominently and fit with two massive CBD street parties. The result is four days jam-packed with activities and a festival feel not found at any other rally event in the country.

PRIMA TOUR

"PRIMO FUN" THURSDAY 26TH NOVEMBER

OPEN TO MODERN AND CLASSIC CARS

The Shannons Prima Tour is integrated into part of day two of the Adelaide Rally. Total distance travelled is approximately 150km. This is the event for you if you want to rub shoulders with notable drivers and have a great day out on the roads without competition pressure. The Prima Tour includes 5 closed road activities before lunch at Bridgewater Mill (TBC). Closed and open roads are travelled at signposted limits. Want more than this? Have a look at the Main and Spirit Tour Categories. -

Vehicle Requirements - Modern or Classic Car with current road registration.

Licencing requirements - Single event licence is included in the cost. Civil Drivers licence required.

Format: Participants will run behind the main Adelaide Rally and leave Adelaide Showgrounds at approximately 9:30am for the first stage of the day. There will be a regroup / morning tea at Foxfield oval late morning. Lunch at Bridgewater will be served after the final closed road stage. The group travels in a packet with tour leaders and followers in the group to monitor activity. Speeds on public roads are at signposted limits with the freedom of using both sides of a closed road stage.

Participants receive - Commemorative Road Book, Caps, Bonnet Decal and lunch at Bridgewater Mill.





MAIN TOUR

THE FREEDOM OF CLOSED ROAD TOURING **\$1745**

The Shannons Adelaide Rally Tour runs over three days. Nowhere in Australia is there a tour with so many separate activities packed into three days. Entrants are embraced as a key part of the Adelaide Rally and vehicles are displayed at all elements, including the famous Gouger Street Party and East End Finale' Party in the heart of Adelaide.

Vehicle Requirements - Modern or Classic Car with current road registration, hazard triangles plus 1kg fire extinguisher meeting general requirements.

Licencing requirements - Level 2S CAMS Licence. [Available online](#) with current CAMS affiliated club membership. Current civil driver's licence.

Format: Participants will run ahead of the field of competitors in packets, each with a tour leader, who sets a swift and enjoyable pace on narrow, serpentine roads.

Participants will take part in Gouger Street Party, East End Finale' Party and over 23 stages in the event, some up to 19km long. Vehicles must be displayed at the street party events.

Participants receive - Commemorative Road Book, Caps, Vehicle Signage and Finisher's Medallion. Lunch each day catered by Taylor and Holmes



SPIRIT

"REDEFINING THE SPIRITED DRIVE"



SPIRITED DRIVING IN A CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENT \$2345

The Shannons Adelaide Rally Spirit Category runs over the Thursday , Friday and Saturday. The category is non-competitive and untimed.

Vehicle Requirements - Modern or Classic Car with current road registration, hazard triangles, 1kg fire extinguisher plus other general requirements. Rallysafe monitored. Rallysafe fitting kit must be purchased and fitted. www.rallysafe.com.au . The Rallysafe monitoring unit is provided by the event for the duration.

Licencing requirements - Level 2S CAMS Licence. [Available online](#) with current CAMS affiliated club membership. Current civil driver's licence. Helmets required on closed road activities.

Format: Our tour leaders set a swift pace on this processional (no overtaking) tour in packets of vehicles, each fitted with a rallysafe monitoring device. Participants are released at short intervals and limited to 120kph on closed roads, which are narrow, twisting and technical. Event penalties apply for breaches. Participants will take part in the Gouger Street Party and all stages on Day 2,3 and 4 of the Shannons Adelaide Rally. Vehicles must be displayed at street party events.

Participants receive - Commemorative Road Book, Caps, Vehicle Signage and Finisher's Medallion. Lunch each day catered by Taylor and Holmes





CHALLENGE

"CHALLENGE YOUR LIMITS"

**COMPETITION WITH LIMITS...
THE PLAYING FIELD JUST GOT EVENED UP. \$2545**

The Shannons Adelaide Rally Challenge Category runs over the entire four day event. The category is timed and trophies awarded.

Vehicle Requirements - Modern or Classic Car with current road registration plus other general requirements. Half Roll Cage required, HANS device and harnesses required.

Rallysafe monitored. Rallysafe fitting kit must be fitted. Check the Supplementary Regulations for Vehicle Technical Regulation/ Modification references.

Licence Requirements - Level 2S CAMS Licence. [Available online](#) with current CAMS affiliated club membership. Current civil driver's licence. Helmets required on closed road activities.

Format: Participants will leave at 30 second intervals on closed road stages. Competitors will be timed and the competition run under rally regulations. Terminal speeds will be limited to 130kph on closed road activities. Time Penalties will be applied for breaches. Fastest time wins. Participants will take part in Gouger Street Party and the East End Finale' Party and each of the activities in the event. Vehicles must be displayed at street party events.

Participants receive - Commemorative Road Book, Caps, Vehicle Signage and Finisher's Medallion. Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd place in Classic and Modern categories. Lunch each day catered by Taylor and Holmes

The Shannons Adelaide Rally Competition is the premium category in the four-day event. The category is timed and trophies awarded.

Vehicle Requirements - Both Classic and Modern (post-1985) categories are catered for. Full Roll Cage required. Cars to comply with CAMS Tarmac or Gravel rally regulations as per supplementary regulations. Rallysafe monitoring used plus other general requirements.

Category S - Non-compliant cars may be eligible for special demonstration Category S inclusion provided they meet general and safety requirements and the spirit of the event.

Licence Requirements - Drivers - [CAMS National Rally Licence](#). Navigators must have a minimum [Single Event Rally Navigator's Licence](#). Current civil driver's licence. Full CAMS tarmac rally safety gear required.

Format: Participants will leave at 30 second intervals on closed road stages. Competitors will be timed and the competition run under rally regulations. Participants will take part all street party events .

Participants receive - Commemorative Road Book, Caps, Vehicle Signage and Finisher's Medallion. Trophies will be awarded to Outright 1st, 2nd & 3rd place in Classic and Modern categories. New for 2020- several sub category awards for: 2WD Modern Cars and Under 3 litre and Over 3 litre categories for both Modern and Classic categories. Lunch provided by Taylor and Holmes catering



HERITAGE TROPHY



CLASSIC HANDICAP COMPETITION

The Heritage Trophy is run within the Shannons Classic Competition and by default, all who enter the Classic Competition are eligible. Using a performance factor applied to each vehicle's times advantages are delivered to those with smaller engines and lower power to weight ratios.

For 2020 the performance matrix has been modified to further benefit small capacity engined vehicles under 2001cc in capacity.

The competition is reminiscent of the Heritage Handicap Trophy competition held within the golden years of the Classic Adelaide Rally. Trophies will be awarded to first, second and third place.





ROUTE



The Shannons Adelaide Rally route is in draft stage pending approvals. The draft itinerary is at right. The event takes in a series of closed road stages up to 19 kilometres long. There are up to 30 stages planned. The closed road stages are highly technical, serpentine and challenging hillclimb style roads. Many of these sections are taken from iconic Classic Adelaide Rally stages of old, such as Basket Range, Norton Summit, Gorge, Corkscrew, Chain of Ponds and more. New additions and some not seen for some time are: Snake Gully, Chain of Ponds Plus, Heysen, Mt George, Lobethal, Leawood Gardens, Myponga, Morialta, Castambul, Sturt Valley.

The 2020 route has been designed to deliver good access for local community traffic whilst reducing resident impact. The overall touring distance of the event is under 700kms. The furthest closed road stage from Adelaide is 58km away. The entire closed road course can be recce'd in one day. Competitive distance is near 175km.
